Goldman Philanthropic Partnerships and

One of the hallmarks of both **Goldman Philanthropic Partnerships** and *Partnership for Cures* is transparency. Therefore, we make all of our financial records available to the public.

As a private foundation, Goldman Philanthropic Partnerships is required to file a 990 PF every year, and has done so since its inception in 1998. The fiscal year for GPP is April 1-March 31, so the 990 PF for the fiscal year recently concluded is not yet complete, but past 990 PF filings can be viewed by going to [www. Guidestar.org](http://www.Guidestar.org). Once you are on the Guidestar home page, search the term Goldman Philanthropic. You will need to register with an e-mail address and password. If you do not want to register there, these 990PF documents from 2003, 2004 and 2005 are also available on our own website by going to:
